- Increase in the Group's consolidated revenue compared to the same period of the previous year.
- Commencement of the 2023 sugar cane campaign under challenging climatic conditions.

Q1 OPERATIONAL INDICATORS 2023

Preparations for the 2023 sugar cane campaign took place under difficult conditions characterized by drought and low water dams levels. These circumstances required strong mobilization from all agricultural partners and on-the-ground support from the upstream agricultural team to mitigate the effects of the rainfall deficit.

Consolidated revenue at the end of March 2023 stands at 2 512 M MAD, showing a slight increase compared to the same period of the previous year. This improvement is primarily driven by growth in sales in the domestic market.
