QUARTERLY INDICATORS AS OF SEPTEMBER 30TH, 2023 cas

Casablanca, November 29th, 2023

- Steady supply of the national sugar market ensured by the industrial performance of the Casablanca refinery.
- Slight increase in domestic market consumption coupled with a decrease in exportable sales volumes.
- Production of 224 Kt of white sugar from the agricultural campaign, compared to 321 Kt in the previous campaign.

OPERATIONAL INDICATORS 2023

Despite the rainfall deficit and the very low water dams levels that characterized the sugar campaign, COSUMAR Group, with the support of institutional partners, local authorities, and agricultural partners, deployed all necessary resources to mitigate the impact on the campaign. Consequently, the production of white sugar from the agricultural campaign totaled 224 Kt in 2023, compared to 321 Kt in the previous year.

Consolidated revenue as of the end of September 2023 amounted to 7 658 M MAD, reflecting a slight decrease of 3% compared to the same period last year. This decline is attributed to the reduction in exportable sales volumes.

The net debt of COSUMAR Group stands at 1 796 M MAD as of the end of September 2023, compared to 985 M MAD at the end of December 2022, impacted by the significant increase in international raw sugar prices in 2023.

Investments recorded as of the end of September 2023 amount to 130 M MAD, primarily focusing on the continued upgrades and maintenance of industrial equipment. (*) IFRS
